Junior Parents/Guardians

During Junior year, families and students are invited to meet with their counselor for an individual 30-minute advisement session regarding remaining graduation requirements and post-secondary plans. Please sign up for a **Junior Advisement Appointment** with your student's counselor. Appointments run through mid-December. Please click on the link next to your assigned alpha counselor to take you directly to a Bookings page and follow the instructions. We encourage you to book a time that coincides with your student's lunch or maybe an elective period if possible. Students will be responsible for making up any work that is missed. As a reminder, please bring a copy of your student's Social Security number to the meeting; this will be helpful in allowing you and your student to gain access to their personal HOPE Scholarship information.

PSAT Results



Yesterday, November 6th, PSAT/NMSQT results were made available!

If your student provided their mobile number on test day, they should have received a text message with access to the <u>BigFuture School mobile app</u>. If they did not provide their mobile number, as always, they may view their scores online by logging into their <u>College Board account</u>. PSAT Results and College Admission Testing Information Meeting

On Monday, November 13th, join us for a PSAT Results and College Admission Testing Family Information Meeting at 6:30 pm in the PAC. The Pope Counseling Department and a representative from Applerouth Tutoring Services will discuss understanding and utilizing PSAT results and will take an in-depth look into the SAT and ACT college admissions tests, the current trends and insights, the transition to the digital SAT starting in March 2024 (the last paper-pencil SAT will be December 2, 2023), and crafting your ideal SAT/ACT testing timeline.

The SAT is Going Digital

Starting in 2024, the SAT will be digital, and registration is now open for the March, May, and June test dates. Most colleges, including those that are <u>test optional</u>, consider SAT scores when making admission and placement decisions, and test scores may be required for certain scholarships. 21st Annual Alfred Street Baptist Church HBCU Festival

Alfred Street Baptist Church presents its 21st Annual Historically Black College & University (HBCU) Festival, a hybrid event being held **November 17-18**. The festival is dedicated to connecting high school students and their families to HBCUs and scholarship opportunities. Approximately 80 colleges and universities will be represented during the two-day event. Many will provide on-the-spot admission decisions, conduct music auditions, and waive application fees. Additionally, seminars and exhibitor presentations will be held to help students navigate the college application process, seek financial aid opportunities, and acclimate them to campus life.

Since 2003, this one-of-a-kind college fair has connected more than 60,000 attendees to academic institutions. In 2022, nearly \$4M in scholarships were awarded to the high school seniors in attendance; many of whom were first generation college students. Additional details can be found here.

Jackie Robinson Foundation Scholarship

Do you know promising college-bound, minority high school seniors? The 2024 Jackie Robinson Foundation (JFR) scholarship application is now open! JRF Scholars receive grants of up to \$35,000 over four years to supplement the financial aid they receive from their colleges or universities. In addition, Scholars receive extensive support services, including career guidance

and internship placement, and attend JRF's annual multi-day "Mentoring and Leadership Conference" in New York City and other regional events throughout the year.
