My Chats

PPO OFFICE "PUPIL PERSONNEL OFFICE"

- AKA the "attendance office"
- Located across from the Main Office
- Absence notes must be submitted within 3 days, and one day for tardies-per Cobb County policy.
- Obtain Certificates of Attendance for driver's license
- Automated phone calls go out for absences, even from one period (check ParentVue for details)

HOW DO I CHECK OUT OF SCHOOL EARLY?

All this info is available in the Student Handbook!!

Student - bring your check-out note to PPO on the morning of your dismissal. Each note must include:

- -The student's name.
- -The parent's name and signature.
- -The student's I.D.
- -The reason for the early dismissal request.

Make sure proper individuals have "release to" and communication rights for each student enrolled in Pope. You can check this in ParentVue.

- -A telephone number where the parent can be reached.
- -If being picked up, the student will exit the building once signed out through PPO.
- If you need to pick up your student and have not made previous arrangements through PPO, you will need to come into the school to check your student out.
- Please bring ID.

SENIOR/JUNIOR PARKING

- Pope Seniors are eligible for parking
 - -Juniors Lottery process
 - -Students can lose parking privileges for excessive tardies/absences.
- "Late Request for Fall Parking" application and other paperwork required found on Pope Website (scroll down past splash page)
- Complete the three forms, and then email them to: Lela.carnes@cobbk12.org
- Let her know that you are a new enrollee and are applying for a parking space.


LEARNING COMMONS

- Required to take state End of Course Tests (EOC) and PSAT



- Free and reduced pay lunch is available (must apply)
- Students can bring their own lunch (microwave available)

Pre-Pay through MyPayments Plus or student bring check Save time when coming through the serving line and add funds to your cafeteria account with a major credit card by telephone (1-866-535-1707), or at MyPaymentsPlus.com.

ATHLETIC PASS PAY CLASS DUES TO RECEIVE AN ATHLETIC PASS

- The sports pass (student's only) is \$70.
 - Individual ticket prices
 - \$10-varsity football,
 - \$12-varsity softball or baseball doubleheaders,
 - \$8-varsity basketball
 - \$6-all other sports
- Mathematically, the sports pass pays for itself after attending a maximum of 9 events
- Class Dues includes the Athletic Pass for students and can currently be purchased on My Payments Plus. A receipt from MPP can be presented at the Sports Pass table during Greyhound Madness for a promo code to be used on GoFan to redeem for a 'free' sports pass.
- Every student purchaser will also receive a Bleed Blue T-Shirt. Promo codes and t-shirts will most likely be available at lunch periods the first week of school and possibly other times to be scheduled later.

- Volunteer Hours are NOT required to graduate, but highly recommended for community engagement and college admissions
- 120 volunteer hours required to earn a Service Cord at graduation (60 hours have to be earned through Pope ex: SGA, Pope Clubs)
- Hours must be accounted for each year (i.e., cannot submit 9th grade hours in senior year)

Honor Cord- 3.5 or higher overall weighted GPA by end of Senior Year

Academic Letter - awarded to students who have earned a 4.0 overall GPA in both fall and spring semester of a school year

National Honor Society- Jrs. and Srs. 3.9 overall weighted and higher (students must apply by the deadline – Ms. Malafronte – Rm. 94)
