Welcome back, Greyhounds! Following is this year's first edition of the Tuesday Telegraph from the Counseling Office. The weekly newsletter provides lots of important information for families regarding college applications and mini-fairs, scholarship opportunities, counselor class lessons, as well as grade level specific information that you'll want to know!

Seniors - Class of 2026!

Welcome back, Class of 2026, to your SENIOR YEAR! We Counselors have some specific information and events planned for you, starting August 12, to help you with college applications, career searching, financial aid, and more! Things to know:

- 1. Take note of our **new alpha-changes**! If your counselor changed, we are already getting acquainted with your records and are excited to work with you and help you along your journey.
- 2. You will be receiving a copy of a **Senior Status Report** along with a new transcript in the next few days that shows you your credit counts and remaining graduation requirements. If you are missing a class that you are not enrolled in, you need to see your counselor ASAP! It is very important that you share this with your parents.
- 3. **Naviance is being updated** to prepare for this year's application cycle. Certain features are currently turned off, such as Letters of Recommendation, Colleges I'm Applying To, etc. until we finish our preparations. We will give you specific instructions during FutureFocus on how to properly navigate everything! In the meantime, you can be working on (and even submitting) applications.
- 4. Starting August 12 during AOs, counselors will be presenting **FutureFocus**, a series of 12 lessons designed to help answer your questions about post-secondary options, including the college application process, building a list, seeking financial aid, choosing a great career that fits your abilities and preferences, and more!
 - a. Those who are off campus (CVA, GAVS, DE, AM Min Day) during AO are strongly encouraged to attend FutureFocus, if you are able to do so.
 - We will post the presentations in the Senior Counseling CTLS as well as on <u>www.popeschoolcounseling.com</u> for students who are absent and parents who wish to view the information.
 - c. Students unable to attend the first two AO sessions are encouraged to attend Senior Parent Night to get the most important pieces of information, such as using Naviance, how to request transcripts/letters of recommendation, etc.

Senior parents/guardians are invited to attend Senior Parent Night where we will review steps that we've shared with students on post-secondary options, the college application process, as well as additional information to help you and your senior along this school year. Rising Juniors – Important Immunization Information

Per the Georgia Department of Public Health, effective July 1, 2021, children 16 years of age and older, who are entering the 11th grade (including new entrants), must have received one booster dose of the meningococcal conjugate vaccine (MCV4), unless their initial dose was administered on or after their 16th birthday. Please visit this link for a summary of requirements for vaccinations by age.

In accordance with this requirement, all Pope students entering the 11th grade, who were 16 by yesterday, August 4th, must submit an updated Certificate of Immunization, on GA Form 3231, to the Pope Counseling Office as soon as possible. Students, who are not yet 16 will have 30 calendar days from the student's 16th birthday to provide the updated Certificate of Immunization. Students must meet this requirement, or provide acceptable exemption documentation, for them to be/remain enrolled in school. Students requesting to be exempt from Immunization must present a signed, notarized Affidavit of Religious Objection to Immunization, DPH Form 2208.

We prefer that you upload your updated Certificate of Immunization/Affidavit of Religious Objection to Immunization to ParentVUE. Once logged in, you will click on Change My Information \rightarrow Student Information \rightarrow Enrollment Documents where you will be able to upload the document. Paper and emailed copies will be accepted as well.


